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- 3. $x^2 3x 1 = 0$ (sort of fancy... just right!)

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
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"Oh, for @#%& sake!"

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$$x = 3/2 + \sqrt{13/4}$$
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and
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Mathematical Proof

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Give them the Magic Formula,

$$ax^2 + bx + c = 0 \Longrightarrow x = \frac{-b \pm \sqrt{b^2 - 4ac}}{2a}$$

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and tell them to try this first next time...
