MSCS Undergraduate Awards & Scholarships for 2008

The Department of Mathematics, Statistics, and Computer Science is pleased to announce two new awards for our majors, the *ComEd Scholarship* and the *Kurtin Scholarship*, each worth \$2000! In addition, you may also apply to be considered for the *Herbert Alexander Award*. Act Now! The deadlines are March 1 and March 15!

The Department has another new award, founded by one of our own graduates, the *Nicholas A. Yassan Award*. The deadline for consideration of this excellent award is next September.

Herbert Alexander Award (\$1,000) - Deadline March 15, 2008

- * Undergraduate or graduate students in the Department of MSCS
- * Must be majoring in Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science
- * Must be in good academic standing with a minimum of 3.0/4.0 GPA

ComEd Scholarships (\$2000) - Deadline March 1, 2008

- * Must be a currently enrolled, full-time undergraduate or graduate student in MSCS.
- * Must be an Illinois resident.
- * Minimum 3.0/4.0 GPA to qualify for application.
- * Completion of 6 or more credit hours at UIC of MSCS coursework at the Math 180 or above level.
- * Preference is given to students of Latino background.

Bernard Kurtin Scholarships (\$2000) - Deadline March 15, 2008

- * Undergraduate or graduate students in MSCS
- * Minimum of 60 semester hours completed (junior standing), with at least three upper level core courses beyond the Calculus sequence
- * Outstanding GPA in major courses (at least 3.5/4.0 GPA)
- * Excellent GPA in all undergraduate courses (at least 3.0/4.0 GPA)

Nicholas A. Yassan Award (\$600) - Deadline September 19, 2008

- * Undergraduate or graduate students in the Department of MSCS
- * Must be in good academic standing with a minimum of 3.0/4.0 GPA
- * Minimum of 60 semester hours completed in the Department of MSCS
- * Minimum of eight credit hours completed in the Department of MSCS
- * Preference given to female students
